

2007 MEMBERSHIP AND TONNAGE

As of December 31, 2007, LCA represented 18 American companies whose combined vessel roster totaled 62 U.S.-Flag vessels operating exclusively on the Great Lakes. These vessels had an aggregate Gross Registered Tonnage of 961,196 and a per-trip carrying capacity of 1,964,589 net tons at mid-summer draft.

2007 VESSEL SALES

In November, Grand River Navigation Company, Inc. sold the *Calumet* to International Marine Salvage for scrapping in Port Colborne, Ontario, Canada. The vessel was built in 1929 for the Bradley Transportation Co. and launched as the *Myron C. Taylor*. (The Bradley fleet was eventually combined with USS Great Lakes Fleet.) The vessel was acquired by Grand River Navigation in 2001. The *Calumet* served the short-haul limestone, coal and salt trades and had a capacity of 13,944 net tons at mid-summer draft.

2007 VESSEL NAME CHANGES

The *David Z. Norton* was renamed the *David Z.*, and the *Earl W. Oglebay* was renamed the *Earl W.*

2007 VESSEL ENROLLMENTS AND DISENROLLMENTS

No vessels were enrolled during the year. The *Calumet* was disenrolled from the Association upon its sale for scrapping in Canada.
