

2006 MEMBERSHIP AND TONNAGE

As of December 31, 2006, LCA represented 18 American corporations whose combined vessel roster totaled 63 U.S.-Flag vessels operating exclusively on the Great Lakes. These vessels had an aggregate Gross Registered Tonnage of 961,197 and a per-trip carrying capacity of 1,964,589 net tons at mid-summer draft.
