## **2006 GREAT LAKES DRY-BULK COMMERCE**

The major Great Lakes dry-bulk trades totaled 168.8 million net tons in 2006, an increase of 2.4 percent over 2005, and 3 percent better than the trades' 5-year average. The vast majority of these cargos were hauled by U.S.- and Canadian-Flag Lakers; ocean-going vessels are almost exclusively engaged in the grain trade (although they have begun to load some iron ore for export overseas). U.S.-Flag carriage and the major cargos are analyzed separately in following sections. However, a common theme runs through all the reports. Cargo totals continue to be negatively impacted by the decades-long dredging crisis on the Great Lakes.
