2004 LIMESTONE TRADE

The Great Lakes limestone trade totaled 40.2 million net tons in 2004, the highest level recorded since 1998.

The 2004 stone float also represents increases of 17.7 percent compared to 2003 and 8.1 percent compared to the 5-year average. Again, the increase over 2003 largely reflects the sluggish demand that characterized most of that year, but 2004 shipments also benefited from fewer weather-related delays in the spring and late fall compared to 2003.
